

SNOW TO SAND KILIMANJARO CLIMBING EXPEDITION 2

Africa is a continent of huge extremes, and nothing can bring this to light better than climbing Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, and then flying a mere two hours straight to the equatorial Indian Ocean island of Lamu, in Kenya.

Kolunga Village Foundation is organizing a fund-raising trip to Mt. Kilimanjaro, followed by three days at Peponi Hotel (one of *THE* best private lodges in all of Africa) on Lamu Island.

The trip will be limited to 10 guests and Mark Ross, a long-time naturalist guide and Kenyan resident, who has summited Kili 15 times, will be guiding and flying this safari (www.markrosssafaris.com).

At 19,336 feet, snow-capped Mt. Kilimanjaro is the highest mountain in Africa and the tallest freestanding mountain known to man, and it is the world's tallest walkable mountain. We will climb through 5 different climatic zones to reach the summit. Our path will be the Umbwe Route, the best of the shorter routes and heralded as the most beautiful on Mt. Kilimanjaro.

After our summit we'll fly to Lamu Island, basing ourselves out of Peponi Hotel. We'll go fishing, swimming, diving, sailing at night under the stars; bop into Lamu town to try the street food; and basically just soak it all up and relax. Lamu Island is a World Heritage Site and you'll be amazed by its beautiful endless beaches, ancient culture, fabulous food and warm ocean breezes.

Participants will be asked to get "sponsors-per-foot" to benefit **Kolunga Village Foundation**. The Kili Climb Fund will help us to build outhouses, wash stations and fund our clinic, all to improve the health and sanitation in Kolunga village, located on Rusinga Island, Lake Victoria, Kenya.
